8th Grade Holiday World Trip

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Holiday World trip is a reward for middle school accomplishments and an incentive to finish 8th grade on a positive note through good behavior and continued academic effort. We are happy to provide this trip at the end of your child's middle school experience, but this trip must be earned.

General Information: The Holiday World trip will be Thursday, May 18th, which is next to the last day of school. Students will report to school as usual and we will leave for HW at approximately 8:30am. Students will be released to enjoy the park with their friends for the day, but students are reminded that EVSC school rules still apply in regards to general behavior and especially in regards to unauthorized items that are not allowed on EVSC property or during EVSC events. The expectation is that students will meet at the big fountain at approximately 4:30pm (more specific time will come the day of the trip) to board buses and return to Perry Heights sometime between 5:45-6:00pm. Students must have their own way home from Perry Heights. This information is also discussed on the second page of this letter.

Guidelines to Participate: Listed below are reasons a student will lose this opportunity.

- Two referrals to the office due to behavior (**Includes dress code, gum & electronic violations**)
- First consequences of AEA (In School Suspension): *If a student is assigned AEA for violating school rules, he/she will not attend HW.
- One out of school suspension: Any discipline action that results in a student being suspended from school or assigned to the CARES program will result in automatic loss of attending HW.
- Two or more F's at the end of school on Friday, May 12th: All students have seven classes. If a student is failing one class we will still let him/her attend HW. If he/she is failing more than one class, the student **will not** be allowed to attend.
- ***Mrs. Lindauer and Mr. Hille reserve the right to deny any student the opportunity to attend HW if a student acts in a way that they feel is grounds for automatic loss of attending HW.
- **Please return a check (made out to Perry Heights) or cash, (\$36) and the attached Parent Permission page by Monday, March 20th.**

The behavior stipulation began after I spoke to the 8th graders in the auditorium on March 13, 2017. Please discuss this letter and the guidelines with your son/daughter, and then sign the second page and have your child return it to the main office or his/her homeroom teacher.
