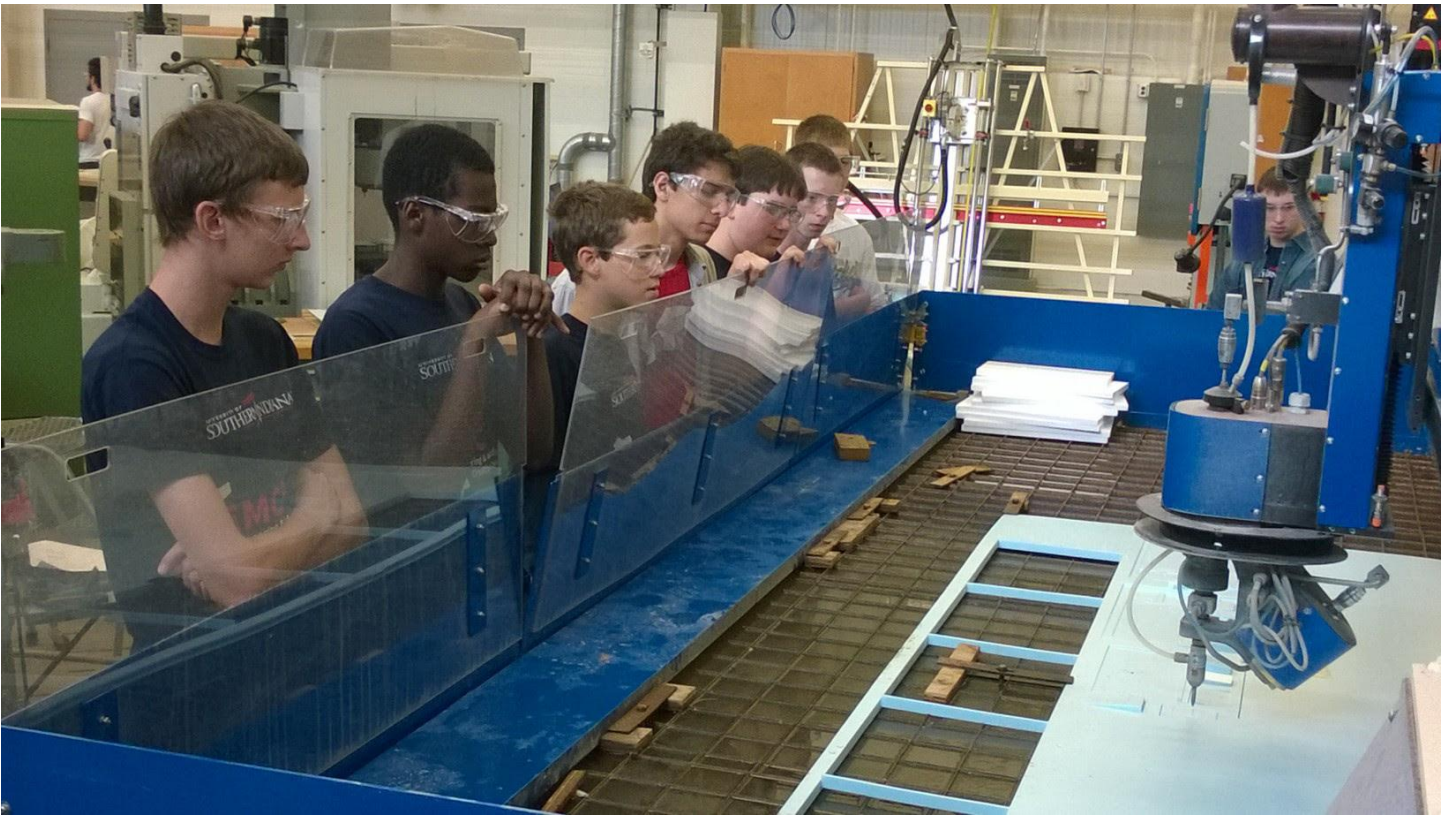


Swi-Stem Summer Camp
